Dear Crestline Student Parent or Guardian,

Throughout the school year the classroom teachers have been keeping track of barriers to learning in the classroom. Some of these barriers being tracked are being tardy to class, being unprepared for class or disrupting the class and stopping the learning of other students. Your student has been identified as having difficulty with at least one of these barriers to their learning in the classroom.

To help your student we are assigning a teacher mentor that will meet with them at least twice each day, once at the beginning of the day and once at the end. At these brief meetings they will discuss how the student is doing in class and make personal goals. The mentor will provide support and strategies for being successful in school and track the progress of the student. At the beginning of each day the mentor will give the student a blue card that the student will take with them to each class. The card will enable the student to get feedback each period on how well they did in class. At the end of the day the card will be turned into the mentor and the two can conference one more time before they leave.

The mentor selected already has a positive relationship with the student and it is our hope that through this relationship your student will be encouraged to develop skills that will make them successful in school. The cards will be utilized no more than four weeks. At the end of the four week period the student will either show that they have developed the necessary skills or they will be moved to more intense behavior interventions.
